Dear Holy Trinity Family,

Welcome to the season of Advent - a time of waiting and preparation.

You can purchase just the item that is listed on the angel, or if you'd like, you can add some additional surprises to your package that you think the child would like. Gifts should be wrapped with the angel securely attached to the outside of the package and returned to the Chrismon Tree in the sanctuary. All Angel Tree gifts are due back to church by Sunday, December 8th. We are on a tight schedule with Little Mountain Elementary School, so it is very important that all gifts are brought in by the deadline! Monetary donations are accepted to help purchase gifts for the children. We also need volunteers to shop for gifts with donated funds. Please put the angel you choose in a safe place so it doesn't get lost. If you choose an angel and see you can't sponsor that child, please put the angel back on the tree or let us know.
