“And what more shall I say? For time would fail me to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets— who through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, were made strong out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. Women received back their dead by resurrection. Some were tortured, refusing to accept release, so that they might rise again to a better life. Others suffered mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment... And all these, though commended through their faith, did not receive what was promised, since God had provided something better for us, that apart from us they should not be made perfect.” --

Dear Holy Trinity Family,

The writer of Hebrews has given us a long list of what we might call “heroes of the faith.”

And the focus isn’t so much on what they did, but on their faith in God who inspired them to do those deeds and gave them the strength to face many, many hardships in life. In many ways, these heroes inspire and encourage us all these years later.

I’m also quite certain that this was not an exhaustive list. You can probably think of many others from the Old and New Testaments. And then there are other non-biblical “heroes of the faith” like Martin Luther who were pivotal to the faith journey of the Church by helping to reform it.

But you can also probably name many heroes that you know personally. I’m talking about people like Sunday school teachers, youth leaders, pastors, parents, grandparents, and all those who “let their light shine before others, giving glory to their Father in heaven.”

I would encourage you to take some time today to think about these “heroes of the faith” in your life – the people who have encouraged you to grow in faith, who have inspired you by their faith, who have prayed for you in times of trouble, and who have held you in their hearts.

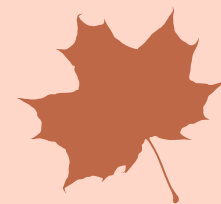
Take a few minutes to thank God for them. And then take a few more minutes to ask God to use you to be a “hero of the faith” for someone else.
